## Grand Junction, Colorado

## August 17, 1932

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Those present and answering at roll call were Councilmen Bear, Glassford, Hirons, Holcombe, Sievert, and President Hall. Councilman Roberts was absent. City Manager Soderstrum, City Attorney Adams, and City Clerk Tomlinson were present.

The minutes of the regular meeting held August 3rd were read and approved.

Credits on account of vacancies for water

The matter of giving credit on account of vacancy, for water accounts, when two properties are on the same line, without separate shut offs, was brought up and discussed thoroughly by the Council. It was decided that it is impossible to give credit under the conditions set forth, without amending the ordinances of the City.

City Manager Soderstrum stated that he had been offered \$10,000 City of Grand Junction Water bonds maturing in 1933, by the Colorado Nat'l. Bank, Mr. Soderstrum was requested to get price, and all information on the bonds and report back to the Council later.

It was moved by Councilman Sievert and seconded by Councilman Bear that the meeting adjourn.
