At a previous meeting held by the directors of the Associations, they had agreed to request that all tax-making bodies lower taxes materially the coming year. Mr. Gormley acted as Chairman of the Committee and stated that they would be glad to assist the Council in preparing the 1933 budget so that all items could be cut as much as possible.
