

Grand Junction, Colorado

September 27, 1933

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colo. met in regular adjourned session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Those present and answering at roll call were: Councilmen Carson, Ross, Oates, Boston, Roberts, Hall and President Holcombe. City Manager Soderstrum, City Attorney Bowie and City Clerk Tomlinson were present.

A proposed emergency ordinance entitled, "AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PARK DEPARTMENT", was introduced and read.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Hall that the foregoing entitled emergency ordinance be passed and adopted, numbered 505, and published. Roll was called on the motion with the following result: Councilmen voting AYE - Carson, Ross, Oates, Boston, Roberts, Hall and Holcombe. All members of the Council voting AYE, the President declared the motion carried and the ordinance duly passed and adopted.

The preliminary 1934 budget was discussed at length.

It was moved by Councilman Hall and seconded by Councilman Carson that the motion passed adopting Ordinance No. 505 be rescinded and stricken from the minutes. Roll was called and all members of the Council voted AYE. Motion was carried.

Councilman Carson thereupon moved, seconded by Councilman Oates, that the City Manager be authorized to pay out of the Special Contingent Fund an amount equal to the net receipts obtained from the dedication football game, dance, benefit game, to apply on the installation of flood lights and necessary maintenance costs in the operation of the lighting system installed upon the Athletic field at Lincoln Park. Roll was called and all members the Council voted AYE. Motion carried.

The City Manager was instructed to interview the County Commissioners and the School Board for School District No. 1, and obtain their attitude on the 1934 levy, before the City Council passes on the City levy and the budget.

It was regularly moved, seconded and carried that the meeting adjourn.
