## Grand Junction, Colorado

## March 7th, 1934

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Carson, Ross, Oates, Boston, Roberts, Hall, and President Holcombe. City Attorney Bowie and City Clerk Tomlinson were present. City Manager Soderstrum was absent.

The minutes of the regular meeting held February 21st, and the regular adjourned meetings held February 26th and March 5th, 1934, were read and approved.

The Proof of Publication to the ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 145 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 198, was presented and read.

It was moved by Councilman Hall and seconded by Councilman Carson that the Proof of Publication be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Councilman Oates then moved and Councilman Carson seconded the motion that the ordinance be called up for final passage. Motion carried.

It was then moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Ross that the ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 145 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 198", be passed and adopted, numbered 517 and published. Upon which motion the following vote was cast:

Councilmen voting AYE - Carson, Ross, Oates, Boston, Roberts, Hall, and Holcombe.

Councilmen voting NO - None.

All of the Councilmen voting AYE, the President declared the motion carried, and the ordinance duly passed and adopted.

Councilman Hall moved and Councilman Oates seconded the motion that the City Manager be instructed to provide adequate ventilation for the Council room. Motion carried.

Several other matters were brought up and discussed, but no action taken on them.

It was moved by Councilman Boston and seconded by Councilman Ross that the meeting adjourn.
