

Grand Junction, Colorado

November 19, 1934

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in special session at 8:00 o'clock A. M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Carson, Oates, Boston, Hall, and President Holcombe. Councilmen Roberts and Ross were absent. City Manager Soderstrum and City Clerk Tomlinson were present.

Owing to the necessity for calling a meeting of the Council on short notice, and each member having been duly notified, it was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Hall that the provision set forth in Ordinance No. 502 providing that notice be served upon the individual councilman be waived Councilman be waived, and that the said call is hereby ratified. All members of the Council present voted AYE. Motion carried.

The meeting was called for the purpose of discussing the repairs to be made to the reservoir. Mr. E. J. Gottula and Mr. Mayfield from Pueblo were present.

Mr. Gottula made a proposition to the Council as follows: that for his expenses, and the cost of transportation of equipment from Pueblo, \$500.00. Then, he would furnish a foreman and the use of his equipment for 20 days at \$50.00 per day, and any time after 20 days at \$25.00 per day. Mr. Gottula agreed to move the sections of the reservoir that had become displaced, and after the foundation is fixed, to put the sections back onto the base.

It was moved by Councilman Hall and seconded by Councilman Carson that Mr. Gottula's proposition be accepted, and the work proceed forthwith. Roll was called upon the motion with the following result: Councilmen voting AYE, Carson, Oates, Boston, Hall, and Holcombe. Councilmen voting NO, None. All of the Councilmen present voting AYE, the President declared the motion carried.

Councilman Hall moved and Councilman Oates seconded the motion that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
