

Grand Junction, Colorado

September 18, 1935

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Ross, Oates, Boston, Enstrom, and Carson. Councilmen absent - Holcombe and Roberts. City Manager Soderstrum was absent. City Attorney Bowie, City Clerk Tomlinson, and Bruce Brownson, Chief of Dept. of Health and Parks were present.

The minutes of the regular meeting held September 4th were read and approved.

Mr. John Cadez presented an application for a liquor license for the American Liquor Store, 357 Main St.

It was moved by Councilman Enstrom and seconded by Councilman Oates that a retail liquor store license be granted to John Cadez for the sum of \$50.00 until December 31st, 1935, subject to the issuance of a State license. Motion carried.

A letter from Herbert F. DeWeese requesting that he be given a lease on the Municipal Airport. It was moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Boston that the letter be accepted, filed, and to be considered further at a later meeting of the Council.

The matter of a traffic light on the intersection of Fifth Street and Main Street was brought up and discussed, and referred to Mr. Soderstrum. He to get data on same, and bring before the Council at the next meeting.

It was moved by Councilman Enstrom and seconded by Councilman Oates that the meeting adjourn.
