

Grand Junction, Colorado

November 15, 1935

All members of the Council having been duly notified, the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in special session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Councilmen present were Ross, Holcombe, Oates, Boston, Enstrom, and President Carson. City Manager Soderstrum, City Attorney Bowie, and City Clerk Tomlinson were also present.

The meeting was called for the purpose of considering the 1936 budget, and other business that might be properly brought before it.

Mr. Enstrom reported that he had been to Denver on a committee meeting and had met with Mr. Vail and other members of the State Highway Dept. and the Bureau of Public Roads regarding the underpass on South Fifth Street. It was Mr. Enstrom's opinion that the State Highway Department do not think it advisable to build an underpass, but the overpass will no doubt be constructed in the near future.

The balance of the meeting was devoted to the discussion of the 1936 budget.

It was moved by Councilman Oates and seconded by Councilman Boston that the meeting adjourn.
