The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were Ross, Holcombe, Oates, and Carson. Councilmen absent were Boston, Roberts, and Enstrom. City Manager Soderstrum, City Attorney Bowie, and City Clerk Tomlinson were present.

The minutes of the regular meeting held December 18th were read and approved.

The application of Glenn A. Woods for a beer license at 132 South 5th Street was presented. It was moved by Councilman Holcombe and seconded by Councilman Oates that the application of Mr. Woods be accepted and license be granted to him to sell 3.2 beer. Motion carried.

The bond of Francis I. Stringer, City Treasurer, was presented, having been approved as to form by the City Attorney. It was moved by Councilman Oates and seconded by Councilman Holcombe that the bond be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Mr. J. S. Gormley presented an application to purchase the tax sale certificates Nos. 39738 and 40678 on the Swanson property located at 8th and Rood. Mr. Gormley offered \$285.89 for the certificates.

It was moved by Councilman Holcombe and seconded by Councilman Ross that the City Treasurer be authorized to sell and assign Special Assessment Tax Sale Certificates numbered 39738 and 40678 for \$285.89, at any time within thirty days from and after this date; providing the purchaser and assignee thereof also pay or settle the general taxes on the property in question, within such period. Roll was called on the motion and all of the Councilmen present voted AYE on the motion. The motion was declared carried.

The bonds for Chas. Koehler, plumber and Hale & Jordon, auctioneers, were presented, having been approved as to form by the City Attorney.

It was moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Holcombe that the bonds be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

The bond of H. C. Frahm, for garbage collection, was presented, having been approved as to form by the City Attorney. It was moved by Councilman Holcombe and seconded by Councilman Oates that the bond be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Oates that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
