## Grand Junction, Colorado

## January 29, 1936

All members of the City Council having been notified according to the ordinances governing the calling of special meetings of the City Council, the City Council met in special session at 7:30 o'clock P.M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Ross, Holcombe, Oates, Boston, Roberts, Enstrom, and President Carson. City Manager Soderstrum, City Attorney Bowie, and City Clerk Tomlinson were present.

Messrs. Bush and Egbert appeared before the Council in regard to Mr. Egbert doing sewer work within the City. The matter was referred to the Plumbing Board.

Mr. Brownson was present and talked to the Council in regard to the Orchard Mesa Cemetery, and the feasibility of putting this cemetery into perpetual care, if possible. The matter was discussed in detail, and it was decided that the individual owners of the lots in the cemetery should be contacted to see just how much money could be raised for this purpose and report be made to Council at a later date.

The White Eagle Oil Co. presented an application for a 28-foot driveway on 5th Street and Ute Avenue. It was moved by Councilman Holcombe and seconded by Councilman Enstrom that the request of the White Eagle Oil Co. for a driveway at their filling station on 5th & Ute be granted. Motion carried.

The Mutual Creamery requested that they be allowed to put in a layback curb in front of their property on South Avenue. It was moved by Councilman Enstrom and seconded by Councilman Oates that the request of the Mutual Creamery for a layback curb the full width of their building be granted. Motion carried.

The matter of purchasing a street sweeper for the City was brought up and discussed. It was decided that Mr. Soderstrum get full details and prices and see what could be done in this connection.

It was moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Enstrom that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
