Grand Junction, Colorado

September 9, 1936

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular adjourned session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Ross, Holcombe, Groves, Boston, Carson, Enstrom, and President Oates. City Manager Soderstrum, City Attorney Bowie, City Clerk Tomlinson, and Bruce Brownson, Chief of the Department of Health and Parks were present.

The White Eagle Oil Co. made application for twenty-four feet more driveway into their filling station on 7th and Main St. They asked to be allowed to concrete the present grass plot at the north end of their present driveway and install steel plates over the present gutter. The Council were not in favor of increasing the amount of the driveway on 7th St. There already being a 68-foot driveway there. Mr. Beyer finally requested then, that he be allowed a twenty-foot driveway on the alley, providing that he close twenty feet of the present driveway.

It was moved by Councilman Enstrom and seconded by Councilman Holcombe that the White Eagle Oil Co. be allowed to construct a twenty-foot driveway on the alley and close twenty feet of the present drive. Motion carried.

The following entitled proposed ordinance was introduced and read: "RELATING TO ORCHARD MESA CEMETERY". It was moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Enstrom that the ordinance be passed for publication. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Ross that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
