Grand Junction, Colorado

October 28, 1936

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular adjourned session at 7:30 o'clock P.M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Ross, Holcombe, Groves, Boston, Carson, Enstrom, and Oates. City Manager Soderstrum and City Clerk Tomlinson were present. City Attorney Bowie was absent.

Mr. Soderstrum presented a detailed report on Proposed Amendment No. 5, which is to be voted on by the State of Colorado at the election Nov. 2nd. He showed that would happen to cities, counties, and schools if this amendment should pass.

The following entitled proposed emergency ordinance was introduced and read: "An Emergency Ordinance Providing An Appropriation for the Highway Department and the Police Department". It was moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Carson that the ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 558 and published. Roll was called on the motion with the following result: Councilmen voting AYE - Ross, Holcombe, Groves, Boston, Carson, Enstrom, and Oates. Councilmen voting NO - None. All of the Councilmen voting AYE, the President declared the motion carried.

A proposal to purchase the tax sale certificates on Lots 1 to 7, Block 20, for face value, was made by O. L. Littlejohn and W. B. Else.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Ross that the City Treasurer be instructed to sell and assign Special Assessment Tax Sale Certificates Nos. 36811 and 37028-34, for face value, at any time within thirty days from and after this date, providing the purchaser and assignee thereof pay or settle the general taxes on the property in question within such period. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

Mr. Scott Heckman presented an application for a rooming house license for Mrs. N. R. Cadwell at 461 South Sixth Street. It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Boston that the license be granted to Mrs. Cadwell. Motion carried.

The balance of the meeting was spent in discussing matters in connection with the 1937 budget.

It was moved by Councilman Enstrom and seconded by Councilman Groves that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
