Owing to the necessity for calling a meeting of the Council on short notice, and each member having been duly notified, it was moved by Councilman Holcombe and seconded by Councilman Carson that the provision set forth in Ordinance No. 502 providing that notice be served upon the individual Councilman be waived, and that the said call is hereby ratified. All members of the Council voted AYE, and the President declared the motion carried.

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Dr. E. H. Munro, Dr. A. P. Drew, and Bruce Brownson were present and discussed with the Council the matter of new regulations concerning the sale of meat within the City.

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO FOODS" was presented, read, and discussed at length by the Council. Several suggested changes were made, and the City Manager instructed to draw a new ordinance to be submitted to the Council at their next regular meeting.

It was moved by Councilman Holcombe and seconded by Councilman Groves that the meeting adjourn.
