

Grand Junction, Colorado

December 27, 1937

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular adjourned session at 7:30 o'clock P.M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Ross, Holcombe, Groves, Boston, Carson, Oates and Enstrom. City Manager Soderstrum and City Clerk Tomlinson were present. Mr. W. R. Hinman, Attorney was also present.

Amendment to meat ordinance

A proposed ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15 OF ORDINANCE NO. 578, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY" was presented and read. It was moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Carson that the ordinance be passed and adopted as read, numbered 587 and published. Roll was called on the motion with the following result: Councilmen voting AYE, Ross, Holcombe, Groves, Boston, Carson, Oates, and Enstrom. Councilmen voting NO - None. All of the Councilmen voting AYE, the President declared the motion carried.

bids for Library Bldg.

Mr. Soderstrum reported that bids had been opened at 2 P.M. for the general contract for the library building, and that the following bids had been submitted.

The following resolution was presented and read:

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BID OF OLSON AND PENNOCK OF DENVER, COLORADO, ON THE GENERAL CONTRACT FOR THE LIBRARY BUILDING AT GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO.

"WHEREAS, the call for bids has been duly advertised and bids received, tabulated and given consideration by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, for the furnishing of all materials and labor required under the General Contract for the erection and completion of the Library Building at Grand Junction, Colorado, hereby determines and declares that the bid of OLSON & PENNOCK of Denver, Colorado, is the lowest and best bid submitted".

"THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of

Grand Junction, Colorado, that the bid of OLSON & PENNOCK of Denver, Colorado, in the sum of Sixty-two Thousand Three Hundred Forty-seven Dollars (\$62,347.00), being the lowest bid submitted, be and the same is hereby approved and accepted and the President of the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to execute the necessary Contract Documents for the erection of the said Library Building at Grand Junction, Colorado, with the said OLSON & PENNOCK of Denver, Colorado, for the total amount of said bid of \$62,347.00."

It was moved by Councilman Holcombe and seconded by Councilman Groves that the resolution be passed and adopted as read. Roll was called on the motion with the following result. Councilmen voting AYE: Ross, Holcombe, Groves, Boston, Carson, Oates, and Enstrom, Councilmen voting NO. None. All of the Councilmen voting AYE, the President declared the motion carried.

Mr. Soderstrum reported that he had received bids on pipe for the Struthers Ave. line, as follows:

It was moved by Councilman Groves and seconded by Councilman Holcombe that the contract for the pipe be awarded to the American Cast Iron Pipe Co. for the amount of \$4,691.47. Roll was called on the motion with the following result: Councilmen voting AYE - Ross, Holcombe, Groves, Boston, Carson, Oates, and Enstrom. Councilmen voting NO - None. All of the Councilmen voting AYE, the President declared the motion carried.

Bids were also received on 2 valves, 4000# of lead and 150# of jute as follows:

It was moved by Councilman Holcombe and seconded by Councilman Groves that the contract be awarded to Crane-O'Fallon for \$885.14. Roll was called on the motion with all members voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

It was then moved by Councilman Groves and seconded by Councilman Oates that the meeting adjourn.
