

Grand Junction, Colorado

August 19, 1938

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, having been duly notified according to the Ordinances of the City, met in special session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Ross, Enstrom, Boston, Carson, Oates, and Groves. Councilman Holcombe was absent. City Manager Soderstrum, City Clerk Tomlinson and City Attorney Hinman were present.

Mr. Soderstrum reported that he had had several telephone conversations with the Ft. Worth P.W.A. office, and that they were not willing to grant any extension of time that would allow to have the entire project advertised. They had suggested however, that if the Council cared to advertise for one week, so that work might be commenced on September 3rd, they would approve that.

Sewer bids rejected

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Ross that all the bids for the Sewer on Fourth Street from Grand to North that were receive on August 17th, be rejected. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council present voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

Readvertise for bids

It was then moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Enstrom that the City Manager be instructed to again advertise for bids for the construction of a sewer on Fourth Street from Grand Avenue to North Avenue, bids to be opened on August 30th at 10:00 o'clock A.M. in the City Manager's office. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council present voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

Some discussion was had concerning the closing of the West Main Street crossing and the construction of the viaduct on West Grand Avenue. No action was taken.

It was moved by Councilman Enstrom and seconded by Councilman Ross that the meeting adjourn until Tuesday, August 30th, at 7:30 o'clock P.M. Motion carried.
