

Grand Junction, Colorado

September 23, 1938

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular adjourned session at 7:30 o'clock P.M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Ross, Holcombe, Enstrom, Boston, Carson, Oates, and President Groves. City Manager Soderstrum, City Attorney Hinman, and City Clerk Tomlinson were present.

Cecil Wilson and Harold Richardson, representing Sentinel-Richardson Office Supply Co., Glen Hopper, Winfield's, Inc; Mr. Nelson, Bannister's; and T.J. Treece, Treece Furniture Co. were present.

Councilmen Holcombe and Enstrom made reports on their investigation as to whether local merchants might be able to furnish the necessary furniture for the Library Building. Mr. Fuller, Architect had wired requesting that the Council defer action, if there was any misunderstanding, until he could meet with them.

It was moved by Councilman Holcombe and seconded by Councilman Ross that the meeting adjourn until Wednesday, September 28th, at 7:30 o'clock P.M. at which time Mr. Fuller would meet with the Council. Motion carried.
