## Grand Junction, Colorado

## May 1st, 1939

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 10:00 o'clock A.M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were Ross, Holcombe, Boston, Carson, Campbell, Luebbert and Treece. City Manager Soderstrum, City Attorney Hinman, and City Clerk Tomlinson were present.

Councilmen Luebbert, Treece and Campbell were sworn into office by Helen C. Tomlinson, Notary Public.

It was moved, seconded and carried that Councilman Ross act as Temporary Chairman. He then took the Chair, and announced that nominations were in order for President of the Council.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Campbell that Councilman Boston be nominated for President of the Council. Motion carried.

It was then moved by Councilman Holcombe and seconded by Councilman Carson that the nominations close, and the Clerk be instructed to cast a unanimous ballot in favor of Councilman Boston for President of the Council. Motion carried. Councilman Boston then took the Chair and was sworn into office as President of the Council and Ex-Officio Mayor.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Ross that the appointment of other officers be deferred until the regular meeting of the Council Wednesday, May 3rd. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Campbell that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
