

Grand Junction, Colorado

June 21, 1939

The City council, of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in special session at 7:25 o'clock P. M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Ross, Campbell, Luebbert and President Boston. Councilmen absent - Holcombe, Carson, and Treece. City Attorney Hinman and City Clerk Tomlinson were present. City Manager Soderstrum were absent.

It was moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Campbell that formal notice of special meeting be waived. Motion carried.

The City Clerk reported that no protests had been filed in connection with the proposed annexation of Brown's Addition to the City of Grand Junction.

It was moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Luebbert that the Proof of Publication to the proposed ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO BROWN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION", be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Councilman Campbell then moved and Councilman Ross seconded the motion that the proposed ordinance be called up for final passage.

The ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO BROWN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION", was then read. It was moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Luebbert that the ordinance be passed and adopted, numbered 607 and published. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council present voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Campbell and seconded by Councilman Ross that the meeting adjourn and convene in regular session. Motion carried.
