

Grand Junction, Colorado

August 30, 1939

Pursuant to notice published in regular form, the City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in special session to consider the annexation of Slocom's Addition to the City of Grand Junction. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Ross, Holcombe, Campbell, Luebbert, Carson, Treece, and President Boston. City Manager Soderstrum, City Attorney Hinman, and City Clerk Tomlinson were present.

A petition of remonstrance signed by a number of the property owners of Slocomb's Addition was presented by Attorney Raso. He stated that he represented 23 residents of this district and that they were protesting on account of the increase that would be made in their taxes.

It was moved by Councilman Holcombe and seconded by Councilman Luebbert that action upon this matter be deferred until the next regular meeting of the Council on Sept. 6 in order to permit checking the remonstrance petition and further advisement of the Council. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Holcombe that the special meeting adjourn and the Council reconvene as an adjourned meeting of August 16th. Motion carried.
