## Grand Junction, Colorado

## October 22, 1941

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular adjourned session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Carson, Ross, Boston, Robb, Treece and President Campbell. Mr. Frank A. Hoisington, who had previously been sworn into office assumed his duties as Councilman at this time. City Clerk Tomlinson was absent. City Manager Brownson and City Attorney Hinman were present.

It was moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Treece that City Attorney Hinman be appointed Acting City Clerk, in the absence of City Clerk Tomlinson. Roll was called on the motion and all members of the Council voted Aye. The motion was carried.

The budget for the year 1942 was presented and studied.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Treece that the City Attorney be directed to write to the County Treasurer requesting his authority for deducting 2% from the City taxes collected through his office. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Boston that the City Manager be authorized to send a representative to the Fire Def. Training School. Roll was called on the motion with the following result: Councilmen voting AYE - Carson, Ross, Hoisington, Boston, Treece and Campbell. Councilmen voting NO - Robb. A majority of the Councilmen voting AYE, the President declared the motion carried.

Communications from J. D. Stirling, Business Agent of The Grand Junction Building Trades Council and The Plumbers Union were read and discussed. It was moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Carson that the communications be received and filed and answered by the City Manager. The motion was carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Ross that the meeting adjourn until Wednesday, October 29, 1941, at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Motion carried.
