An application for a beer license was made by Sam Pantuso for a grocery store at 811 South 7th St. It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Treece that the license be granted when Mr. Pantuso has received his State license. Motion carried with Councilman Ross voting NO.

Bonds for the following were presented, having been approved as to form by City Attorney Hinman: - Joe Leff and Earl Van Gundy, Junk dealers. Manchester Bros. cement contractors; and West Advertising Agency. It was moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Robb that the bonds be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

City Manager Brownson read a letter from a coordinating committee, requesting that the Council have a representative at an organization meeting which will be held at the Mesa College on January 12th. This organization to be a representation of every club, organization etc. in the City to be a sort of clearing house for all war activity work. President Campbell was delegated to attend the meeting.

City Manager Brownson also reported on activities to date in the Defense Council work.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Hoisington that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
