

Grand Junction, Colorado
February 13, 1942

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, having been duly notified, met in special session at 1:30 P.M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Carson, Ross, Hoisington, Boston, Robb, Treece, and President Campbell. City Manager Brownson, City Attorney Hinman and City Clerk Tomlinson were present.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Ross that the Council waive 24-hour notice of meeting. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

The matter of investing Water Department funds was brought up and discussed. City Manager Brownson had been advised by the First National Bank that there was a new issue of U. S. Government 2 1/4% bonds and if the City desired to invest their Water funds in these bonds, a wire subscribing the desired amount should be sent at once.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Robb that the City Manager be instructed to purchase \$30,000.00 U. S. Government 2 1/4% bonds for the investment of Water funds. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Treece that the meeting adjourn until Wednesday, Feb. 18, 5:00 o'clock P.M. this meeting to be in lieu of the regular 7:30 meeting.
