

Grand Junction, Colorado
June 17, 1942

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Carson, Ross, Hoisington, Boston, Robb, Campbell, and President Treece. Also present were City Manager Brownson, City Attorney Hinman, and City Clerk Tomlinson.

The minutes of the regular meeting held June 3rd were read and approved.

It was moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Carson that Virgil P. Groves be appointed as Judge of the Municipal Court. Motion carried.

City Manager Brownson reported that the paving contract on the airport was practically completed and that the electrical work would be complete in about three weeks. He stated that he and City Attorney Hinman had been in Denver and had gone into the matter of a lease, and had discussed several matters in connection therewith. He also stated that he and several Grand Junction business men were going to Salt Lake and Ogden Thursday to see if there were any new developments in the use of the airport.

Mr. Brownson made a report on the Colorado Municipal League Convention at Ft. Collins which he attended, stating that it was one of the best of these conventions.

Mr. Jos. Moser requested that the beer license from 715 North 12th St. be transferred to 741 Main St. The State office had authorized the transfer of the State license. It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Campbell that the request be granted. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Hoisington and seconded by Councilman Carson that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
