

Grand Junction, Colorado
October 14, 1942

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular adjourned session at 7:30 o'clock P.M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Ross, Carson, Hoisington, Boston, and Robb. Councilman Campbell and President Treece were absent. City Manager Brownson, City Attorney Hinman and City Clerk Tomlinson were present.

It was moved by Councilman Hoisington and seconded by Councilman Ross and duly carried that Glen L. Robb be appointed as President of the Council pro tem. Councilman Robb thereupon presided for the balance of the meeting.

City Manager Brownson asked the Council about donating the old cannon in Whitman Park for scrap for the war effort. It was moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Hoisington that the cannon in Whitman Park be donated to the scrap drive. Motion carried.

It was then moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Ross that the cannon be sold and the funds derived from the sale of same be donated to the O.C.D. Roll was called on the motion with the following result: Councilmen voting AYE - Carson, Ross, Hoisington, Boston, Robb. Councilmen voting NAY - None. All of the Councilmen present voting AYE, the President pro-tem declared the motion carried.

Councilman Carson expressed his thanks for the flowers sent to his brother's funeral.

The preliminary budget for the year 1943 was presented and the balance of the meeting devoted to the study of said budget.

It was moved by Councilman Hoisington and seconded by Councilman Carson that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
