

Grand Junction, Colorado

January 13, 1943

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in special session at 5 o'clock P.M. Wednesday, January 13th. Present and answering at roll call were: Councilmen Carson, Ross, Hoisington, Boston, Robb, and Campbell. President Treece was absent. Also present were City Manager Brownson, City Attorney Banks, and City Clerk Tomlinson.

It was moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Robb that Councilman Hoisington act as President Pro-tem. Motion carried and Councilman Hoisington took the Chair and presided during the meeting.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Ross that the usual 24-hour written notice of call for special meeting, be waived. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council present voting AYE. The motion was declared carried.

City Manager Brownson reported that the hangar at the airport had burned on January 8th, and that the Council meeting had been called to consider the matter of rebuilding the hangar and constructing other necessary buildings at the airport. Mr. Brownson estimated that it would cost approximately \$5,329.85 for a hangar including a class room and a building 30 x 40 to be used for repairing and servicing the airplanes. The City has some materials on hand that can be used in the construction of the hangar. He suggested that the City let a contract for the labor for the construction of the buildings, and purchase the materials themselves.

It was moved by Councilman Ross and seconded by Councilman Carson that the City Manager be authorized to let a contract for the labor for the construction of an airplane hangar, class room and repair shop, to the best advantage for the City. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council present voting AYE. The President pro-tem declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Campbell that the City Manager be authorized to file an application with the Federal Works Agency for contributions providing community service under the Lanham Act funds, to be applied to the Mesa County Service Center, Inc. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Ross that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
