## Grand Junction, Colorado

## August 26, 1943

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado met in regular adjourned session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Carson, Ross, Hoisington, Boston, Campbell and President Robb. Councilman Treece was absent. City Manager Brownson, City Attorney Banks and City Clerk Tomlinson were also present.

The meeting was called to discuss with Mr. F. M. (Andy) Veatch matters pertaining to the improvement of the water and sewer systems after the war is over.

After considerable discussion, it was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Hoisington that the City hire Mr. Veatch to make a preliminary survey of the water and sewer systems, on a basis of \$50.00 per day and expenses. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council present answering Aye on the motion. The President declared the motion carried.

Mr. Veatch estimated that it would take him a week or so to make this preliminary survey.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Boston that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
