

Grand Junction, Colorado

October 15, 1943

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado met in regular adjourned session at 7:30 o'clock P.M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Carson, Ross, Hoisington, Boston, Treece, Campbell and President Robb.

The matter of the liquor license for Tony Santy was presented. A letter was read from Joe Keith, Chief of Police. It was moved by Councilman Hoisington and seconded by Councilman Campbell that a restaurant liquor license be granted to Mr. Tony Santy for Santy's Cafe and Lounge, 335 Main Street. Motion carried.

A revised contract for street lighting was presented by the Public Service Co., showing a reduction of \$956.40 per year, was presented. This reduction would be effective October 1st, 1943. It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Ross that the proposed street lighting contract with reduction in rates be accepted and the President of the City Council and the City Clerk instructed to sign same on behalf of the City. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

The tentative budget for 1944, together with a letter of explanation from City Manager Brownson was presented.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Campbell that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
