Grand Junction, Colorado

March 15, 1944

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P.M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were, Carson, Hoisington, Boston, Treece and President Robb. Councilmen Harris and Campbell were absent. Also present were City Manager Brownson, City Attorney Banks and City Clerk Tomlinson.

The minutes of the regular meeting held March 1st and the special meeting held March 11th were read and approved.

Discussion was had concerning the lease with the Horn Processing Company for the administration building. It was agreed to allow this company to construct an addition to the building in conformity with plans approved by the City Engineer. It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Treece that the City Manager be authorized to sign the lease along the lines discussed with the Council. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council present voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

Beer license renewal applications for Rettig's Grocery and East Side Grocery were presented. It was moved by Councilman Boston and seconded by Councilman Carson that the applications be approved and licenses granted. Motion carried.

D. W. Donaldson has purchased Mae's Grocery at 226 Pitkin and presented an application for a beer license at that address. It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Hoisington that the application be approved and license granted. Motion carried.

City Manager Brownson reported that he had received a letter from the Colorado State Highway Department informing him that they did not believe Seventh Street could be designated as an Alternate State Highway on account of the railroad crossing having no protection such as an underpass or overpass, and therefore 3% gasoline tax funds would not be available for the improvement of this street.

The matter of purchasing a new chlorinator was brought up and discussed. It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Treece that the City Manager be authorized to purchase a chlorinator. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council present voting Aye. The President declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Hoisington that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
