

Grand Junction, Colorado

October 4, 1944

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Carson, Treece, Campbell and President Hoisington. Councilmen absent Harris, Robb, Boston. Also present were City Manager Brownson, City Attorney Banks and City Clerk Tomlinson.

The minutes of the regular meeting held September 20th were read and approved.

The Board of Directors of the Rural Fire District, Messrs Patterick, Sullivan and Green appeared before the Council and outlined a proposed plan for rural fire protection. Considerable discussion was had on this subject. It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Treece that the City Manager, City Attorney and Chief of the Fire Department work with the Board of Directors and cooperate in every way in working out the details necessary to establish a rural fire district. Motion carried.

L. D. Harper and D. L. Leach, dba Money Saver Market presented an application for the renewal for their 3.2 beer license. It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Campbell that the license be renewed. Motion carried.

It was reported that lots on the corner of 1st and Teller are not accessible to a sanitary sewer. They had been sold with the understanding that there was a sewer line in the alley adjoining, but upon investigation it appeared that the sewer only came within 100 feet of the lots. It was moved by Councilman Campbell and seconded by Councilman Carson that the City extend the sanitary sewer line to service these four lots on 1st and Teller. Motion carried.

The Recreation Commission have been trying to set up their budget for the coming year, and have determined that they will need approximately \$4,000.00. They have requested that the City and the School District assume this obligation, and have asked that the City provide the sum of \$2,000 in their 1945 budget. It was moved by Councilman Campbell and seconded by Councilman Treece that the City Manager include \$2,000.00 in the tentative 1945 budget. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Campbell that the City Manager secure from the Public Service Co. a copy of their annual report for the last fiscal year. Motion carried.

Mr. Brownson reported that the request of the City to W.P.B. for an order to secure a Payloader had been denied, and that he

had written to H. W. Moore and Co. to see if they were available, and whether to make another application immediately or to wait several months.

President Hoisington reported that he had attended a meeting of the Fire and Police Committee with the City Manager, Police Chief, and Judge of the Municipal Court in regard to traffic violations, etc.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Treece that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
