

Grand Junction, Colorado

October 24, 1944

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in special session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Carson, Robb, Treece, Campbell and President Hoisington. Councilmen Harris and Boston were absent. Also present were City Manager Brownson and City Attorney Banks. City Clerk Tomlinson was absent.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Campbell that the City Council waive the 24-hour notice of special meeting. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Campbell and seconded by Councilman Treece that City Attorney Banks act as Clerk for the meeting.

John Collier gave a report on the recreation program for the summer of 1944, during the present school year and outlined plans for the future.

The tentative budget for the year 1945 was presented. This budget had been prepared on the basis of a General Fund levy of 14.5 and a Library Fund levy of 1.5 mils.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Campbell that the levy for the City of Grand Junction for the year 1945 be set at Sixteen mills. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

A bond for J. W. Tucker and J. A. Butner dba The T and B Electric Service was presented, having been approved as to form by City Attorney Banks. It was moved by Councilman Campbell and seconded by Councilman Treece that the bond be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Campbell and duly seconded that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
