

Grand Junction, Colorado

March 15, 1945

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in special session at 5:00 o'clock P. M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Carson, Harris, Robb, Treece and Hoisington. Councilmen absent were Boston and Campbell. Also present were City Manager Brownson, City Attorney Banks and City Clerk Tomlinson.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Treece that the 24-hour notice of meeting be dispensed with. Motion carried.

The meeting was called for the purpose of discussing the recent 16-inch water main break. This main being the one located under the Colorado River. City Manager Brownson explained that the break was directly under the current of the river and with high water coming in the very near future would be very difficult and expensive to repair, and at best the repairs would be only temporary.

After discussing all phases of the matter, it was moved by Councilmen Carson and seconded by Councilman Robb that the City Manager be authorized to proceed with the installation of a temporary water line across the river and to get in touch with Mr. F. M. (Andy) Veatch for his advice on a permanent structure. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Treece that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
