Grand Junction, Colorado

August 24, 1945

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in special session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Boston, Carson, Campbell and President Harris. Councilmen absent were Treece and Hoisington. Also present were City Manager Brownson, City Attorney Banks and City Clerk Tomlinson. Also Mr. Herbert D. Fritz.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Boston that the 24-hour formal notice of meeting be waived. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Boston that Mr. Herbert D. Fritz be appointed as City Manager of the City of Grand Junction, effective Aug. 25, 1945. Motion carried.

Mr. Fritz then expressed his thanks to Mr. Brownson for his assistance during the past week, in helping him to get acquainted with his new work.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Campbell that on account of the fact that Mr. Brownson had had no vacation for years, he be paid his regular salary for the months of August and September. Roll was called on the motion with all of the members present voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Boston that Mr. Fritz's surety bond be approved and accepted as soon as it has been approved as to form by the City Attorney. Motion carried.

The report of James E. Ragan auditor for the year 1944, was presented. It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Boston that the report be accepted and referred to the Finance Committee. Motion carried.

The firm of Swiney and Farmer made application for a Plumber's license. It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Campbell that the bond of Swiney and Farmer be accepted and filed as soon as it has been approved by the City Attorney as to form. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Boston that the meeting adjourn until Wednesday, August 29th, at 7:30 o'clock P.M. Motion carried.
