

December 28, 1946

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in regular adjourned session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Councilmen present and answering the roll call were: Treece, Hoisington, Boston, Day, Harris, and President Carson. Councilmen absent: None. Also present were City Manager Fritz, City Attorney Banks, and City Clerk Tomlinson.

City Manager Fritz reported that Boettcher & Company, et al, had wired a bid for the purchase of \$430,000.00 for Water Improvement Bonds at par, 1-3/4% interest on maturity to 1957, 2% on the balance. The Council were of the opinion that it would be better to receive bids for the \$430,000.00 balance of Water Improvement Bonds and would not accept the offer of Boettcher & Company, et al.

Ordinances for changing license fees and other fees were then considered.

An emergency ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 238, As Amended, Concerning Licenses" was introduced and read (theaters, and express, taxi, etc.). It was moved by Councilman Harris and seconded by Councilman Treece that the ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 722 and published. Roll was called with all members voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

An emergency ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 481, As Amended, Concerning The Building Code" was introduced and read (building code). It was moved by Councilman Day and seconded by Councilman Boston that the ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 723 and published. Roll was called with all members voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

An emergency ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 484, As Amended, Concerning Plumbing" was introduced and read (Plumbing). It was moved by Councilman Harris and seconded by Councilman Day that the ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 724 and published. Roll was called with all members voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

An emergency ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 638 Concerning Coin Operated Devices" was introduced and read. It was moved by Councilman Treece and seconded by Councilman Hoisington that the ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 725 and published. Roll was called with all members voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

An emergency ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 146, As Amended, Concerning Junk Licenses" was introduced and read (Junk Dealer). It was moved by Councilman Harris and seconded by Councilman Boston that the ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 726 and published. Roll was called with all members voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

An emergency ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 238 Concerning Hotels and Rooming Houses" was introduced and read. It was moved by Councilman Hoisington and seconded by Councilman Harris that the ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 727 and published. Roll was called with all members voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

An emergency ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 528 Concerning Taxi Cabs And For 'Hire' Vehicles" was introduced and read (Taxi Cab Driver's License, etc.). It was moved by Councilman Boston and seconded by Councilman Harris that the ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 728 and published. Roll was called with all members voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

An emergency ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 280, As Amended, Concerning Licenses for Second-Hand Business" was introduced and read. It was moved by Councilman Day and seconded by Councilman Hoisington that the ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 729 and published. Roll was called with all members voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

An emergency ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 154, Concerning Ice" was introduced and read (Ice Truck). It was moved by Councilman Treece and seconded by Councilman Boston that the ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 730 and published. Roll was called with all members voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

An emergency ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 154 Concerning Wage Brokers and Pawn Brokers" was introduced and read. It was moved by Councilman Day and seconded by Councilman Boston that the ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 731 and published. Roll was called with all members voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

An emergency ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 594 Concerning Refuse Hauling" was introduced and read. It was moved by Councilman Treece and seconded by Councilman Hoisington that the ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 732 and published. Roll was called

with all members voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

An emergency ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 422 Concerning Billboards" was introduced and read. It was moved by Councilman Hoisington and seconded by Councilman Harris that the ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 733 and published. Roll was called with all members voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

An emergency ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 546 Concerning Dogs was introduced and read. It was moved by Councilman Boston and seconded by Councilman Day that the ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 734 and published. Roll was called with all members voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

An emergency ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Water Rates" was introduced and read. (Tank Water). It was moved by Councilman Harris and seconded by Councilman Day that the ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 735 and published. Roll was called with all members voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

An emergency ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 20, As Amended, Concerning the City Weigher" was introduced and read. It was moved by Councilman Hoisington and seconded by Councilman Treece that the ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 736 and published. Roll was called with all members voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

An emergency ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 321 Concerning The Moyer Pool" was introduced and read. It was moved by Councilman Harris and seconded by Councilman Day that the ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 737 and published. Roll was called with all members voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

It was regularly moved, seconded and carried that the meeting adjourn.
