Grand Junction, Colorado

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado met in regular adjourned session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. to consider the 1949 budget. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Carson, Hoisington, Bagby, Colescott, Martin, Harris and President Harper. Also present were City Manager Moore, City Attorney Banks and City Clerk Tomlinson.

City Manager Moore presented his proposed 1949 budget and salary and wage schedules for consideration by the Council. It had previously been agreed that the mill levy would be left at the same figure as for 1949 - i.e. 25.5 mills and that Mr. Moore be instructed to request from the State Tax Commission the additional increase in funds which this levy would make because of the increased assessed valuation.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Harris that the budget as proposed by City Manager Moore be approved and adopted. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried. The Clerk was instructed to certify the levy to Mesa County officials.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Hoisington that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
