

Grand Junction, Colorado

May 2, 1949

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado met in regular adjourned session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were: Carson, Hoisington, Colescott, Martin, Harris and President Harper. Councilman Bagby was absent. Also present were City Manager Moore, City Attorney Banks and City Clerk Tomlinson.

The minutes of the regular meeting held April 20th were read and approved.

A letter from Mr. John Page was read, thanking the Clerk for the copy of the Resolution sent him. It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Colescott that the letter be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

City Manager Moore reported that the final report on the Collbran project was now in Washington. He had contacted Rep. Aspinall by telephone and Rep. Aspinall had stated that he would introduce an appropriation bill in the house, so that the financing might be started during this year.

President Harper expressed his appreciation to Councilman Harris for his assistance on the Council during the past year. Several other Council members expressed their regret at Mr. Harris termination of office. Councilman Bagby was also tendered a vote of appreciation for serving a two-year term on the Council.

City Manager Moore extended his thanks to the Council for their co-operation.

President Harper and other members of the Council also expressed their appreciation to Mr. Moore for the manner in which he had managed the affairs of the City and especially that committee meetings and Council meetings had been held at a minimum.

The minutes of this meeting were read, and approved.

It was moved by Councilman Hoisington and seconded by Councilman Harris that the meeting adjourn, sine die.
