

Grand Junction, Colorado

January 27, 1950

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in special session at 7:30 P. M. Councilman present and answering at roll call were Harper, Carson, Dufford, Colescott, Martin, Hansen and President Hoisington. Also present were City Manager Moore, City Attorney Banks and City Clerk Tomlinson.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Colescott that the Council waive the formal twenty-four hours notice of meeting. Motion carried.

Mr. Moore, City Manager, stated that owing to the fact that his health was broken and he was not physically able to continue as City Manager and realizing that this was the case, asked to be relieved of his duties immediately. It was moved by Councilman Colescott and seconded by Councilman Martin that Mr. Moore be relieved of all duties as City Manager at the close of business on Saturday, January 28th, and that John A. Burton be appointed as Acting City Manager for a period of thirty days at the same salary he now receives, and that he furnish a bond to cover the position. Roll was called on the motion with all Councilmen voting "AYE." President declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Martin that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
