## Grand Junction, Colorado

June 26, 1950

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular adjourned session at 10:00 o'clock A. M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were Hanson, Carson, Harper, Dufford, Colescott, Hoisington and President Martin.

An emergency ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 755 AND THE ZONING MAP INCORPORATED THEREIN," was introduced and read. This ordinance changes the zoning on the North side of North Avenue to Cannell and makes all the area from 7th to College Place Business "A" District. Considerable discussion was had concerning this change of zoning. There would then be a larger business district than 1320 feet so the ten foot setback restriction would be removed.

It was moved by Councilman Carson and seconded by Councilman Hanson that the Ordinance be passed and adopted, numbered 809, and ordered published. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council voting "AYE." The President declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Hoisington and seconded by Councilman Hanson that the meeting adjourn.
