

Grand Junction, Colorado

May 7, 1951

President Pro Tem Hoisington asked if there were any further nominations. There being none, it was moved by Councilman Harper and seconded by Councilman Carson that the nominations be closed and a unanimous ballot be cast for Oscar Hanson, Jr., as President of the City Council for the ensuing year. Motion carried. Councilman Hanson then took the chair as president.
