Grand Junction, Colorado March 21, 1957

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in regular adjourned session at 4:00 o'clock P. M. Councilmen present and answering at roll call were Shults, Orr, Harper, Colescott, and President Lowe. Also present were City Manager Cheever, and City Clerk Tomlinson. Absent were Councilman Emerson and City Attorney Ashby. Councilman Wright arrived after the meeting had started.

TO BUY PIPE FROM THOMPSON PIPE & STEEL CO.

City Manager Cheever reported that it would be impossible to contact Mr. Turney until Monday, and that after figuring the cost of delivery and installation, the cost of installing 20 inch steel pipe on Patterson Road would be about \$40,000 less than the cost of installing cast iron pipe. The Thompson Pipe and Steel Co. would deliver the pipe on the job and would have all pipe delivered within 60 days. Armco Drainage and Metal Products were actually the low bidder on steel pipe but the price did not include the cost of delivery on the job and their guaranteed date of delivery would be not earlier than June 30th.

It was moved by Councilman Shults and seconded by Councilman Harper that the City Manager be authorized to purchase from Thompson Pipe and Steel Company 10,200 feet of 20 inch steel pipe at \$6.10 per foot. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council present voting "AYE." The President declared the motion carried.

<u>AIRPORT LEASES.</u> Mr. Cheever presented a map of Walker Field showing the location of leased property, and an area used by larger transient aircraft. Mr. Davis of Monarch Aviation had questioned whether or not this area was in his lease.

City Manager Cheever recommended that control of the area in question should be held by the City and used only for use of larger aircraft. The Council agreed that the City Manager's recommendation should be followed.

It was moved by Councilman Harper, duly seconded and carried that the meeting adjourn.
