The City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in regular adjourned session at 7:30 P. M. Councilmen answering roll call were Shults, Orr, Strnad, and President Emerson. Councilmen Harper, Colescott and Wright were absent. Also present were City Manager Cheever, City Attorney Ashby and City Clerk Tomlinson.

NORTH AVE. WIDENING -- RESOLUTION. The following resolution was presented and read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Colorado State Highway Department has submitted certain plans to the City Council of the City of Grand Junction concerning the widening, re-paving and other improvements from 1st to 8th Streets on North Avenue in the City; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held by the Council on the 3rd day of July, 1957, in which owners of property on North Avenue were heard; and

WHEREAS, although certain difficulties will be encountered by some of the owners on North Avenue directly involved because of parking limitations under the plan, the City would benefit under the proposed plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION

That the plans of the Colorado State Highway Department for the widening and improving of North Avenue from 1st to 8th Street in the City be, and the same are, hereby, approved, with the request that parallel and layback parking be permitted in the improved area if such is possible.

It was moved by Councilman Shults and seconded by Councilman Orr that the Resolution be passed and adopted as read. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council present voting "AYE." The President declared the motion carried.

It was regularly moved, seconded and carried that the meeting adjourn.

This meeting was devoted to the discussion of sewer and water problems in the fringe areas.
