### ROLL CALL

Councilmen present and answering roll call were Hadden, Colescott, Lowe, Wright and President McCormick. Councilman Meacham was absent. Also present were City Manager Lacy, City Attorney Ashby and City Clerk Tomlinson.

#### MINUTES

It was moved by Councilman Colescott and seconded by Councilman Lowe that the minutes of the regular meeting held January 4, 1961 be approved as written. Motion carried.

3.2 BEER LICENSE Granted Pantuso's Pizzaria, 103 No. 1st

This was the date set for hearing on the application for a 3.2 beer license for Pantuso's Pizzaria, 103 No. 1st Street, to be operated by James and Mary Pantuso. There were no petitions or objections filed in connection with this application. **RESOLUTION** Changing voting districts

The following Resolution was presented and read:

# RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado that the councilmanic districts of the City of Grand Junction be changed as to the boundaries of such districts so that said districts are designated and described as follows:

Dist. A

District A shall contain and include all that portion of the City of Grand Junction lying west of Seventh Street and South of Hill Avenue

Dist. B

District B shall contain and include all that portion of the City of Grand Junction lying north of Hill Avenue and West of Seventh Street

Dist. C

District C shall contain and include all that portion of the City of Grand Junction lying east of College Place and North of North Avenue

Dist. D

District D shall contain and include all that portion of the City of Grand Junction lying east of Seventh Street and West of the following described line; commencing at south City limits; thence north along Eleventh Street to 2nd Ave.; thence west to City limits line; thence north along said City limits line to Denver & Rio Grande Western Railroad right-of-way; thence along said right-of-way to extension of Eleventh Street; thence north along Eleventh Street to North Ave., thence West to College Place; thence north along College Place to north city limits.

# Dist. E

District E shall contain all that portion of the City of Grand Junction lying east of Eleventh Street and south of North Avenue.

City Manager Lacy brought to the attention of the Council the fact that the Lincoln Park Golf Course was closed because the dry weather is so hard on the turf. It is impossible to irrigate as the nights are so cold and until we have moisture, the damage through use of the golf course would be irreparable. It was also brought out that the Bookcliff Country Club will close down their golf courses for the same reason.

POLICE To write ltr to Capt Mace Ingraham upon retirement

President McCormick stated that Captain Mace Ingraham was retiring from the Police Department; that he felt the citizens of Grand Junction owe him a debt of gratitude for his long years of service and suggested that a letter of appreciation from the Council be written to Mr. Ingraham.
