February 10, 1965 in the Conference Room of the City Hall to act as a Canvassing Board of the Special Municipal Revocable Permit Election held February 9, 1965 on the question of granting a Revocable Permit to Home-Owned Cable TV, Inc. Evans was absent. Also present were City Manager Lacy and City Clerk Helen C. Tomlinson. City Attorney Gerald J. Ashby was absent.

It was duly moved, seconded and carried that the following Tally Sheet be accepted and filed as the Report of the Canvassing Committee:

We, the undersigned, acting as canvassing board, hereby certify that we have canvassed the returns of the Special Municipal Revocable Permit Election held in the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, on February 9th, 1965, and from the said canvas find the results to be as follows: that 290 ballots were cast in District "A"; that 511 ballots were cast in District "B"; that 923 ballots were cast in District "C"; that 556 ballots were cast in District "D"; that 567 ballots were cast in District "E" and that 36 absentee ballots were cast;

The question submitted was as follows:

"Shall the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, grant a Revocable Permit to Home Owned Gable TV Inc., a Colorado, Corporation, to permit that corporation to use all streets and alleys within the City for installation, operation, and maintenance of a Cable Television System, the City receiving two and one-half percent (2-1/2%) of the gross receipts derived by the corporation from such operation within the City."
