ROLL CALL

RAY A. MEACHAM ELECTED PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL

President McCormick asked for nominations for President of the Council for the coming year. It was moved by Councilman Colescott and seconded by Councilman Wright that Councilman Ray A. Meacham be elected as President of the Council and Acting Mayor of the City of Grand Junction. Motion carried. (7 AYES)

There being no further nominations, it was moved by Councilman Wright and seconded by Councilman Love that the nominations be closed and Ray A. Meacham be elected President by a unanimous ballot. Motion carried. (7 AYES)

Councilman Colescott thanked President McCormick for the very efficient manner in which he had conducted the office of President of the Council and Mayor of the City. All of the Council concurred in these remarks.

C.E. MC CORMICK PERMANENT PRESIDENT PRO-TEM

President Meacham thanked the Council members for the honor they had bestowed upon him, stating that it would be particularly hard to fill the shoes of Mr. McCormick. He asked that Councilman McCormick be given the job of permanent President Pro-tem to attend meetings, give welcoming addresses, etc.
