ROLL CALL

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. September 7, 1966 in the Civic Auditorium at City Hall. Councilmen present and answering roll call were Chas. E. McCormick, Chas. H. Love, Harry O. Colescott, Dr. Hurst F. Otto, Herbert M. Wright and President Ray A. Meacham. Councilman R. B. Evans was absent. Also present were Acting City Manager Helen C. Tomlinson and Acting City Clerk Blanche G. Stringer. City Attorney Gerald J. Ashby was absent.

INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Rev. Joseph F. Kane, Immaculate Heart of Mary Catholic Church.

MINUTES

It was moved by Councilman McCormick and seconded by Councilman Otto that the minutes of the regular meeting held August 17th and the special meeting held August 24th be approved as written. Motion carried. (6 AYES)

HEARING

Lutheran Church, 11th & Teller req for max bldg height

This date had been advertised for hearing on the request of the Lutheran Church, 11th & Teller, to increase the height of their new church building to 44 feet. Architect John Porter had presented plans and a model of the proposed new church building to the Planning Commission at its meeting of August 17th at which time it was approved by the Planning Commission and referred to the City Council. The Lutheran Church has purchased additional land so that there will be adequate parking facilities provided. No written protests were filed and no one appeared to speak against this change. President Meacham closed the hearing.

It was moved by Councilman Wright and seconded by Councilman Love that the Lutheran Church, 11th and Teller, be granted permission to construct their new church building to the maximum height of 44 feet. Motion carried. (6 AYES)

HEARING

Zoning of Willowbrook Annex, 1st & Patterson

This date had been scheduled and advertised for hearing on the zoning of Willowbrook Annexation at 1st Street and Patterson Road. A map was presented showing the proposed zoning. No written protests had been filed and there were no protests from the audience. The President closed the hearing.

EL CORONA ANNEX

REQ LEE A. PEASE FOR Disconnection from

Mr. Lee A. Pease and Mrs. Thelma M. Pease, 2777 F. Road, had appeared at the Council meeting on Aug. 17th and protested against annexation of their property in the El Corona Annexation stating that they had not been aware that they were being annexed. City Attorney Ashby and Mr. Jerry W. Uhrlaub, Attorney for Mr. & Mrs. Pease, had been conferring and the following application for Disconnection was presented and read:

APPLICATION FOR DISCONNECTION

Application is hereby made to the City Council of Grand Junction, Colorado pursuant to the provisions of Colorado Revised Statutes, 1963, 139-20-1, in behalf of Lee A. Pease and Thelma M. Pease, as owners of a tract of land situate within the City of Grand Junction, Mesa County, Colorado, to have the said property disconnected from the City Limits of Grand Junction, Colorado, Applicants' property is described as follows:

Beginning at the NW corner of the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 1 South, Range 1 West of the Ute Meridian thence East 209 feet, thence South 418 feet, thence West 209 Feet, thence North 418 feet to the point of beginning.

As justification for the request of applicants to have the property above described disconnected from the city boundaries of Grand Junction, Colorado, the following is respectfully submitted:

1. The property of the applicants complies with the statute above mentioned in that it is within and adjacent to the boundary of a portion of that area incorporated under Ordinance No. 1230 and annexed to the City of Grand Junction.

2. No specific notice was ever received by the applicants that the property above described was to be included in a proposed annexation to the City of Grand Junction. No petition for annexation was circularized to the extent that the applicants were apprised of the fact that the property above described was to be included in the proposed annexation.

3. Applicants were misled into believing that the annexation was to include the El Corona Subdivision, only, inasmuch as the terminology used in the various news media consistently referred to the annexation as the "El Corona Annexation" as did the annexation map itself.

4. Applicants desire to remain outside of the city limits so long as it is possible so to remain in view of the nature of the use of their property described above, which is used as a family residence as well as for the raising and breeding of horses.

5. That, apparently, the main reason that applicants' property hereinbefore described was included within that area annexed to the City was related to a desire to square off a boundary line; that the records of the City of Grand Junction indicate the annexation petition was circularized by the developer of the El Corona Subdivisions with this subdivision apparently being the basis for initiating annexation proceedings in the first instance; and that in all events, the applicants neither asked nor desired to be included in the annexation so initiated.
