1967 BUDGET

This meeting had been called for consideration of the 1967 Budget. It was moved by Councilman McCormick that the 1967 budget be adopted. Motion was seconded by Councilman Youngerman. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.

ORD. 1248 PASSED

Appropriations for 1967

The following entitled emergency ordinance was introduced and read: AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING CERTAIN SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY THE NECESSARY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1967 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1967 AND FIXING THE SALARY OF THE CITY MANAGER OF SAID CITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. It was moved by Councilman Colescott and seconded by Councilman Wright that the ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 1248 and ordered published. Roll was called on the motion with all members of the Council voting AYE. The President declared the motion carried.
