**MILL LEVY - 14 MILLS FOR 1968 - RESOLUTION**

This meeting had been called for the purpose of setting the mill levy for the year 1968. The following resolution was presented and read:

RESOLUTION

LEVYING TAXES FOR THE YEAR 1967  
IN THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO

BE IT RESOLVED BY the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

That there shall be and hereby is levied upon all taxable property within the limits of the City of Grand Junction, for the year 1968 according to the assessed valuation of said property, a tax of fourteen (14) mills on the dollar (\$1.00) upon the total assessment of taxable property within the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, for the purpose of paying the expenses of the municipal government of said City, and certain indebtedness, including interest upon indebtedness of the City, for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1968.
