RESOLUTION EXPRESSING TO ENERGY RESOURCE INDUSTRY URGENT PLANNING NEEDS OF REGION XI JURISDICTIONS AND REQUESTING STATEMENT ON ITS POSITION RELATIVE TO FUNDING OF INDUSTRIAL AND GOVERNMENTAL COORDINATION PROGRAM

The following Resolution was presented and read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the towns, counties and school districts contained within Colorado Planning and Management Region XI are and will continue to face social, physical and economic impacts from energy resource development within the Region, and

WHEREAS, the towns, counties and school districts in Region XI are presently unable to adequately plan for and manage growth without outside financial assistance, and

WHEREAS, the Colorado General Assembly appropriated \$200,000.00 as matching funds for planning and technical assistance purposes in Region XI, and

WHEREAS, the energy resource industry has been approached by the Colorado West Area Council of Governments and by the several towns and counties within Region XI through the Industrial and Governmental Coordination Program for financial aid;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO:

That the units of local government contained within the boundaries of Planning and Management REgion XI express to the energy resource industry the urgent planning needs of the local jurisdictions and that industry immediately state its position relative to the funding of the Industrial and Governmental Coordination Program.
