ROLL CALL

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in adjourned session on Monday, July 24, 1978, at 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Council members present: Robert Holmes, Lawrence Kozisek, Bill O'Dwyer, Jane Quimby, and President of the Council Karl Johnson. Larry Brown and Elvin Tufly were absent. Also present were City Manager Jim Wysocki, City Attorney Gerald Ashby, and Deputy City Clerk Teddy Martinez.

CONSIDERATION OF DESIGNATION OF HORIZON DRIVE

It was moved by Councilman Kozisek and seconded by Councilman O'Dwyer that Council propose the extension of Horizon Drive from 7th Street to 1st Street and that it strongly recommend in that extension that there be grade separation intersections at both 1st Street and Horizon Drive, and 7th Street and Horizon Drive, and urge the County to extend Horizon Drive from 1st Street to Patterson. Motion carried.

RESIGNATION OF ELVIN G. TUFLY AS COUNCILMAN

The President of the Council announced the resignation of Elvin Tufly from the City Council effective immediately. It was moved by Councilman O'Dwyer and seconded by Councilman Kozisek that the resignation of Elvin Tufly from the City Council be accepted, and that Council begin immediately to recruit a replacement for District D, and that Mr. Tufly be written a letter of appreciation under the signature of the President of the Council. Motion carried.

MISCELLANEOUS DISCUSSION;

City Manager Jim Wysocki reminded Council to be present on the corner of 5th and Main Streets on Tuesday, July 25, to conduct a rap session with the public at that time. Mr. Wysocki also reminded Council that they will be interviewing applicants for the Planning Commission on Wednesday, July 26, 1978, at 7:00 p.m.
