HEARING - PROPOSED 1988 BUDGET

A hearing was held after proper notice on the 1988 Proposed Budget. There was no one present speaking in favor or against the 1988 Proposed Budget. The hearing was closed.

ORDINANCE NO. 2368 - APPROPRIATIONS FOR 1988 WITH AMENDMENTS

Upon motion by Councilman Nelson, seconded by Councilman McCurry and carried, the following entitled proposed ordinance was called up for final passage and read by title only: AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING CERTAIN SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY THE NECESSARY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1988, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1988, AND FIXING THE SALARY OF THE CITY MANAGER OF SAID CITY.

Upon motion by Councilman Mantlo, seconded by Councilman Bennett and carried with Councilman THEOBOLD ABSTAINING, the bids were accepted and the Contract for the Emergency Generator and Installation at Fire Station No. 1 was awarded to B & B Electric in the amount of \$28,700, and the City Manager was authorized to sign said Contract.
