

**GRAND JUNCTION CITY COUNCIL  
MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING**

**January 9, 2002**

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, convened into special session the 9<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2002, at 6:39 p.m. in the Administration Conference Room, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, City Hall, 250 N. 5<sup>th</sup> Street. Those present were Councilmembers Harry Butler, Dennis Kirkland, Bill McCurry, Jim Spehar, Janet Terry, Reford Theobald, and President of the Council Cindy Enos-Martinez. Section 24-6-402(4)(e); specifically instructing negotiators and developing strategy for negotiation on a question arising under the Persigo agreement.

Section 24-6-402(2)(f) and not involving: any specific employee who has requested discussion of the matter in open session; any member of this body or any elected official; the appointment of any person to fill an office of this body or of an elected official; or personnel policies that do not require the discussion of matters personal to particular employees; specifically the discussion will be the evaluation of the City Manager. Councilmember Spehar seconded. Motion carried. The City Council convened into executive session at 6:41 p.m.
