ORDINANCE NO. 94.

Annual appropriation ordinance.

Be it ordained by the city council of the city of Grand Junction, Colorado.

Section 1. That the following sums of money, or so much thereof as shall be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated for defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the city of Grand Junction for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1900 ending March 31, 1901, to-wit:

First—For the purpose of maintaining a police force, \$1800.

Second—For the purpose of maintaining, improving and repairing streets, avenues, crossings, sidewalks, ditches and public parks and for water for irrigation, \$3000.00.

Third—For lighting streets and public buildings, \$1400.

Fourth—For maintenance of the fire department, \$800.

Fifth—For fees and salaries of city officers, other than police officers, \$4750.

Sixth—For the city general fund, \$2500.

Seventh—For city water works expenses \$4000.

Section 2. That there be and hereby is appropriated for the payment of interest on water bonds the sum of \$5000.

Section 3. That for the maintenance of the public library and reading room there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of \$1200.
